CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION
OF
AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS
PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOUNDATION

Susan C. Kaeser, Acting President, and Gregory P. Balbierz, Secretary, of the CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOUNDATION, an Ohio not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), do hereby certify that effective the 16th day of January, 1990, the Corporation and the Cleveland Heights-University Heights Board of Education adopted the Amended Articles of Incorporation as contained in the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Amended Articles of Incorporation attached as Exhibit A hereto are hereby adopted to supersede and take the place of the existing Articles of Incorporation of the Cleveland Heights-University Heights Public Schools Foundation.

Attached hereto is a true and correct copy of the Amended Articles of Incorporation referred to in this Certificate of Adoption.

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AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CLEVELAND HEIGHTS-UNIVERSITY HEIGHTS PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOUNDATION

FIRST: The name of the Corporation shall be Cleveland Heights-University Heights Public Schools Foundation.

SECOND: The place in this State where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of Cleveland Heights, County of Cuyahoga, Ohio.

THIRD: The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for educational, charitable or scientific purposes by conducting or supporting activities for the benefit of the Cleveland Heights-University Heights School District (the "District"), including, but not limited to:

(a) Conducting or supporting activities for the purpose of:

- (1) improving the quality of education in and increasing support for the District;
- (2) increasing community involvement with and support for the District; and
- (3) promoting innovation, excellence and equality in instruction, programs, and facilities of the District;

(b) Accepting and expending funds in support of such activities, programs and facilities as hereinbefore set forth.

(c) Doing all things necessary or appropriate in order to accomplish the foregoing purposes.

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campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of the Code.

FIFTH: It is intended that this Corporation shall have the status of a corporation which is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(a) of the Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and which is other than a private foundation by reason of being described in Section 509(a)(3) of the Code. These Articles shall be construed accordingly, and all powers and activities of the Corporation shall be limited accordingly.

SIXTH: Upon any dissolution of the Corporation, all of the Corporation's property of every nature and description shall, after making provisions for discharge of all known liabilities of the Corporation, be distributed to the Cleveland Heights-University Heights City School District exclusively for its public purposes in trust for such education and charitable purposes to be determined by the Trustees at the time of dissolution.

SEVENTH: The Articles of Incorporation may be amended only upon the vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board of

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Trustees of the Corporation and the approval of the Cleveland Heights-University Heights Board of Education by majority vote.
